# U6/U7

The program is designed to introduce both those new to hockey and those who have played hockey in the previous season, as well, to build confidence and develop a love of the game for years to come! The Mini Thunder U6/U7 Hockey School will focus on skating and fundamentals at the beginning of the season all progressing as the season moves forward.

The U6/U7 Mini Thunder Hockey School is scheduled on Saturdays.

#### U5/U6 Mini Thunder - Beginner session

 Beginner – minimal skating experience, the player has some balance, can shuffle but not fully skate /or has no skating experience.

#### U5/U6 Mini Thunder - Intermediate/Advanced session

• Intermediate/Advanced – strong skating ability, the player can get up on their own and balance, is able to skate the width or length of the ice.

#### U6/U7 Mini Thunder - Beginner session

• Beginner – New to Hockey with some skating experience, player can balance, and skate on their own.

#### U6/U7 Mini Thunder - Intermediate session

 Intermediate – players have good skating ability, and hockey fundamentals i.e., passing, shooting, puck control etc.

#### U6/U7 Mini Thunder – Advanced session

• Advanced – players that have above average ability and are ready for more of a challenge.

<u>Player Placement</u>- Players will be assigned based on their level of skating. This will allow players the opportunity to be placed with more "alike skating levels".

An email will be sent to all players registered mid August as to what session they are to a]end on orienta-on day. Please note: Orienta-on Day will be based on age and alphabe-cal order as we will be placing the players in the appropriate sessions to start for the hockey school.
