



U10/U11/U12/U13 Prep phase and tryouts for Rep Hockey (AA, A, BB)

The U10 to U13 rep hockey program is offered to those players who wish to play a more advanced level of hockey. Following the Hockey Canada/OMHA guidelines for the pathway rep program, HHMH invites all U10 to U13 participants who would like the opportunity to tryout for rep hockey in the upcoming 2021-22 season to the prep development/tryouts starting the week of September 6th!

All players who wish to participate in the U10 to U13 prep development/tryouts for the rep hockey program are required to be registered and purchase a tryout card to attend the prep and tryouts. Registration information can be found on the HHMH website www.haltonhillsminorhockey.com

What is the prep development phase?

- As per Hockey Canada, all players who plan to attend evaluations (tryouts) for tiered level travel hockey (pre-representative hockey) have the opportunity to attend 4 development sessions prior to the evaluation phase.
- The prep phase consists of (4) development sessions that is geared towards working on the player's individual hockey skills; skating, agility, balance, passing, puck control, small area games...
- Drills will be set up in stations geared to focus on individual player skills.
- Players will not be assessed for teams during the evaluations sessions.
- HHMH head coaches along with on ice helpers/assistants will be running the development for the prep phase of the tryouts.

Is it a requirement that all players attend the 4 development session in order to participate in the evaluations?

- The development sessions are optional but recommended and are included in the price of the tryout card. All tryout cards are a set price to include the 4 sessions and evaluations (no adjustments to the price will be given). Players who do not attend the development sessions are still able to attend the evaluations.
- All sessions will start the week of September 6th and are followed by evaluation (tryouts). The schedule can be found under the Tryout menu/Tryout schedule.



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Tryout outline

- Tryouts will follow the prep phase of development
 - Tryouts are an opportunity for players to display their hockey abilities.
 - Each player will be individually evaluated and selected to teams accordingly, based on level of ability and skill. AA, A, BB
 - All evaluation sessions will be organized and run by independent development Instructors.
 - All players/goalies are required to attend the AA tryouts in order to be selected for a rep team.
 - If a player cannot make a tryout, please reference the frequently asked questions under the tryout menu on the HHMH website.
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- Following each tryout, players will be advised as to which tryout they are to continue with/or move to following each evaluation session via website.
 - Each player will receive a tracking number that they will reference on the website following each evaluation.
 - Information will be advised on this system as to where the player has placed/details how to access the site will be provided at the evaluations.
 - Tracking numbers will be issued at the start of the evaluations.
 - NRP Players (non-resident players) are able to attend tryouts starting at U12 (AA ONLY). NRP players are only able to attend the AA tryouts and must have a passport from their home association to attend. NRP players are asked to email, Wendy Highfield at accountant@haltonhillshockey.com to set up payment prior to attending tryouts.

Tryouts will consist of skills and exhibition games, exhibition games are invite only and will be listed by tryout tracking number via our HHMH website. The schedule for the start of all tryouts can be found under the tryout menu on the HHMH website, starting with the age group and AA (i.e. U10AA), as players are released they will follow the next divisions tryout schedule (A then BB).
